- Stabbing near 1st and Ash provided background on owner; long history of problems with this and neighboring home; crack dealing; homeless campground in back; drug deal gone bad; goal is to get it listed as Chronic Nuisance Property & into city hands / torn down or fixed up. It's a dangerous property. ICON will add these houses to problem property tracking for environmental offences: 2015 and 2021 S 1st.
- There are 30k drug users in Springfield, which fuels violence; much of the shootings and homicides are a result of drugs.
- o Report to Mike if you think **homeless** are squatting on vacant property.
- Recreational marijuana will become legal in 2020. Police are not yet aware of how to evaluate "driving while impaired". If they detect odor of marijuana within a car, it's probably cause to search.
- Fireworks report and they will come and cite, especially where egregious, repeated, or late at night.
- Call if you think it's gunshots.
- o Two **dogs** in neighboring yards were poisoned 1400 S 8th Street and died.
- Basketball games in the middle of the street good for kids to have something to do; to get acquainted with police. Let them play; shut down at night (parents tip goal over).
 Concerns about speeding cars hitting kids at night in the dark.
- O Iles Park improvements: discussion on improvements to give kids something to do. Park district has a plan that could include a skateboard park, amphitheater for group performances and other possible amenities see http://www.springfieldparks.org/pdf/lles Park Master Plan Report 3-1-09.pdf Iles Park Neighborhood Association, possibly in partnership with Harvard Park Neighborhood Association and others, should make a plan to get this started again, using volunteer labor, donations, grants.
